4.2.1 --Progress of funding to support Truro by-pass proposal—The Association shall write to DPTI and MMC asking for the results from the recent traffic count taken in town. Pending

4.3 Hall and Oval -

- Phil H reported that he is still working on the repairs to the oval sprinkler and that he had also fixed a leak on the north side of the building;
- ➤ Installation of acoustic tiles the association received a quote from Tristan Kerr of Kerrstructions, a Kapunda based builder. The quote was for \$1,950. Phil H and Phil A made the offer to undertake this work in order to save the association money. They are aiming to commence this project in the next two weeks. Chris F is to loan some scaffolding to assist with the work all agreed to this direction;

4.5.1—Old Council Chambers progress report –The veranda roof and framing have been replaced by a contractor, and damaged timbers in the front door replaced. The framing has been painted and painting is underway on the door. The derelict shed at the back has been removed to clear space for earthworks to improve stormwater drainage. The contractor has invoiced just under \$3000, the amount of the grant from MMC. Additional work is in-kind volunteer labour.

The next main task is to improve drainage at the rear of the building with an on-site inspection scheduled for Sunday 19th April at 2.00pm. A further report will be presented to the next meeting based on this meeting. Re-pointing the stone walls will also take place.

The Association can now acquit this grant and the grant used for paint for the oval fence posts.
