TRURO AND DISTRICT TOWN PLAN 2023 – 2028

The Truro and District Town Plan builds on the community consultation process undertaken in 2022. Each of the Strategic Pillars has Objectives with Activities to form the basis of relevant prioritised Action plans over time. Actions are keyed to Themes, Strategic Goals and Key Activities in Mid Murray Council's Strategic Plan 2020-2024. The Plan was approved in April 2023 and may be modified by the board of the Truro and District Community Association from time to time.

STRATEGIC PILLARS + A VISION FOR TRURO

Vision: Truro is a vibrant town that is socially connected, environmentally sustainable and prosperous. It is a place where residents and visitors to the region enjoy natural beauty, heritage and a great rural lifestyle.

Key Strategic Pillars:

Town activation: Develop and enhance the local economy, innovation, business renewal and tourism.

Advocacy and leadership: Focus on the Truro community's capacity to influence decision makers, form partnerships and attract

investment.

Social Connectedness: Ensure that Truro is resilient and that people in the town and district feel supported and connected and can

access the necessary services.

Town Pride: Focus on heritage preservation and beautification of the town – public art, green space, recreation and sport.

Environment: Preserve, protect and enhance our natural environment and assets for our benefit and that of future

generations.

First Nations heritage and culture: Listen, learn and engage with First Nations peoples to enhance understanding and strengthen relationships.
